Charges for the spaces will be at the weekly rate of \$300, April 3-10, 2023. There is some concern that Texas W may not fill all 40 slots. There are 22 rigs registered at this time. Any unfilled spaces must be turned back 45 days prior to April 3, 2024, or they will be charged to Texas W. Rather than turn them back, they may be offered to friends and family. Deadlines will be set soon.

GNR is now Camp Winnebago. The theme for 2024 Camp Winnebago is "Disco Fever." The dates are July 15-18.
