Up Dating Your Rand McNally Dash GPS? Having Problems?

One of our members, Jack Martin, has some ideas on a possible solution or contacts to help your efforts. Jack sent this information to put in newsletter.

"I could never get my coach GPS to operate correctly and gave up on it, I finally Contacted Winnebago and they directed me to the parent company for Rand-McNally.

The company is called River Park, tel. 800-442-7717.

The attached instructions will take you to the update dash board. It takes a few minutes to register your device (it needs plugged in at this point to your computer) and run the maps update program. It is suggested by the technician, Brad Watson, (574-522-7781 Ext. 328) to run the diagnostics/repair option before removing the SD card from your computer. I did it, and there were 12 files with problems that the software cleaned up. My GPS Model is XSG2NA-X1


